

## Supplementary Information for 2021 Entrance Examinations

Department of Integrated Biosciences, Graduate School of Frontier Sciences, The University of Tokyo

To prevent COVID-19 infection, our department will not hold an on-site TOEFL-ITP test as the English exam. Instead, applicants must submit a score of English tests specified in the revised examination guide. Those who have not obtained a valid score should take one of the tests as soon as possible. Please carefully read the note below as well as the revised entrance examination guide of our department and the guidelines for Applicants to the 2021 Master/Doctoral Course Ver.2.

- “Score” of each test is defined as follows:
  - TOEFL-PBT, TOEFL-iBT, TOEIC open test, and IELTS Academic Module: detailed definition is given in the guidelines for Applicants to the 2021 Master/Doctoral Course Ver.2.
  - TOEFL-iBT Special Home Edition: same as TOEFL-iBT
  - TOEFL-ITP Plus for China solution: Score Report
  - Practical English Proficiency Test (EIKEN): “score reports” (scores of the first stage is acceptable) or “certificates”
  - TEAP: “official score reports”
  - GTEC: “official score certificates”
  - Cambridge: “certificates”
- If applicants cannot upload an electric copy of the score by the due date, applicants may upload a screenshot of the score sheet displayed on the website of the test. Note that the original score sheet must subsequently be sent by post to GSFS Student Affairs Team as soon as it is obtained.
- If a discrepancy is found between the original score sheet and the electronic copy, applicants may have their admission rescinded at any later stage.
- Scores of only listening and reading tests will be used for evaluation.
- No particular English test will give any advantages over another in selection.
- For EIKEN, CSE score will be used for evaluation. Applicants can submit a score report regardless of whether they pass or fail the test of a particular EIKEN grade if the grade meets our standard (see the revised entrance examination guide). Score reports must reflect tests taken after September 1, 2018, for Schedule A.
- We do not accept TOEIC-IP and online version of GTEC Business because of a concern for fraud prevention, in principle.
- Applicants who cannot submit a valid score sheet owing to unavoidable reasons should inform the Entrance Exam Committee ([ib-entrance2021@ib.k.u-tokyo.ac.jp](mailto:ib-entrance2021@ib.k.u-tokyo.ac.jp)) of the fact and the reason from June 18 to August 3, 2020. As exceptions, Entrance Exam Committee may approve the applicants to submit score reports of TOEIC-IP and/or online version of GTEC Business (two or four skills). These score reports must reflect tests taken after September 1, 2018, for Schedule A. The Entrance Exam Committee may request the applicants to submit a document as a proof of the reason. An additional exam for English proficiency may be conducted in the oral examination.
